

OTHER POLICIES AVAILABLE

FARM PACKAGES & UMBRELLAS

The sizable investments in horse farms must be protected from property loss or a potential liability suit. Properly designed farm and umbrella policies provide both security and protection.

COMMERCIAL EQUINE LIABILITY

Coverage to protect and defend commercial horse operations. Available for Boarding and Breeding Facilities, Lessons, Instructors, and Trainers.

PLEASURE/RACEHORSE OWNERS LIABILITY

Designed to provide liability protection and defense for people who own pleasure, show or race horses but who are not involved in a commercial horse business.

CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL COVERAGE

MORTALITY AND THEFT

The first step in building complete equine coverage. Insures the animal against death due to accident, injury, illness or disease. Theft coverage is included.

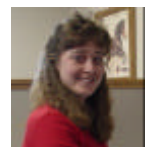
